Such amount shall be equal to the amount of the total appropriations set forth in the budget minus the total amount surplus and miscellaneous revenues set forth in the budget; and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District No. 4 has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District No. 4,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District No. 4, at an open public meeting held on December 4, 2013 that the Annual Budget, including appended Supplemental Schedules, of the Gloucester Township Fire District No. 4 for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2014 is hereby approved; and

For the proposed 2014 budget the additional line for rent reserve improvement of \$30,000 is included to fund additional rents to be paid for repairs, contingent upon the completion of repairs being made to the building. Increased health care and fringe benefit costs are the result of hiring an additional firefighter. The capital improvement to the vehicles is for the purchase of diesel emissions filtering systems for the vehicles.

Complete a brief statement describing the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on the Amount to be Raised by Taxation to support the district budget and on the Restricted and Unreserved Fund Balance(s). Explain increases or decreases in the tax rate and utilization of fund balances. If unreserved fund balance is reduced by more than 10%, explain the projected impact on the following year's budget.

The proposed 2014 budget utilizes \$113,291 of the unrestricted fund balance; this amount reduces the amount to be raised by taxation by \$113,291. Fire District No. 4 expects to exert caution in spending with the hope of not having to utilize as much of the unreserved balance as proposed resulting in minimum impact to next year's budget.

3. Include a statement explaining how the District is complying with the Property Tax Levy Cap. The statement must explain reasons for exceeding the Levy Cap and identify the appropriations that caused the district to exceed the Levy Cap, and how they are being addressed by a referendum.

The 2013 proposed budget complies with the property tax levy cap. The property tax levy cap was adjusted upward above the 2% due to the increased healthcare cost and fringe benefits associated with hiring a second firefighter and for the purchase of the diesel filtering systems.

Recipients of a SAFER grant will be required to submit a semi-annual Federal Financial Report (FFR) via the automated system on the Standard Form 425 (SF-425). The FFR is intended to provide Federal agencies and grant recipients with a standard format and consistent reporting requirements throughout the government. The FFR, to be submitted using the online e-grant system, will be due semi-annually based on the calendar year beginning with the period after the award is made. Grant recipients will be required to submit an FFR throughout the entire period of performance of the grant.

The reporting periods for the FFR are January 1 through June 30 (report due by July 31), and July 1 through December 31 (report due by January 30).

At the end of the grant's period of performance, all grantees are required to produce a final report on how the grant funding was used and the benefits realized from the award. Grantees must submit a final financial report and a final performance report within 90 days after the end of the period of performance.

Article IX - FEMA Officials

Program Officer: The Program Specialist is responsible for the technical and programmatic monitoring of the stages of work and performance of the activities described in the approved grant application.
